

Board Liaison Program Program and Role Description

Program & Position summary:

BC Soccer's is committed to operating in a collaborative manner with its membership. To support this, BC Soccer established the Board Liaison Program which is designed to install one or two BC Soccer board of directors per regional area as points of contact for member organizations to more effectively communicate what BC Soccer is working towards whilst providing an additional way for members to provide feedback to BC Soccer.

BC Soccer board of directors bring any relevant updates to the respective operational areas of BC Soccer and/or provide updates to the entire board at the next meeting.

Regional Areas:

Adult Leagues, Burnaby, Fraser Valley, North & Upper Vancouver Island, North Shore, Northern BC, Okanagan & Kootenays, South Fraser, South Vancouver Island, Tri-Cities & Alouette, and Vancouver & Richmond.

Purpose:

The main purpose for the establishment of this role is to act as a conduit between BC Soccer and the district in areas that can/may be outside the work of BC Soccer staff. There may be concerns/questions about Rules and Regulations, or the way BC Soccer operates that may need further clarifying and the assistance in getting information that the district may need.

Activities that a Liaison should consider including but are not limited to:

- making contact with President of District
- offer to attend District Board Meetings
- attend District Cup Finals and special activities
- attend local games and interact with our community members

Liaisons may come across concerns and situations from clubs specifically regarding the district, which the club is a direct member of, therefore, liaisons may need to consider our membership structure in how they proceed. In other words, when concerns are brought forward, it may be, in the first instance the approach is to listen and then direct them back to their district association.
