Re: Player Registration Fees – Return to Play update Phase 1

On June 2, 2020, BC Soccer provided its Return to Play Phase 1 Plan to its members and affiliated clubs which allows for modified training programming to occur. More detailed information can be found in BC Soccer's Return to Play memo [here](#).

An important requirement of participation is having all players properly registered through BC Soccer's normal registration process. Since the announced its Return to Play Phase 1 Plan, we have received some inquiries on the Player Registration Fees and if they would stay at the same level.

BC Soccer understands that all organizations and individuals within the soccer community in BC have been impacted in some form or another. In light of this and to support the members, clubs and ultimately the players/family, BC Soccer's Board of Directors at the June 27, 2020 Board Meeting agreed that for any players that are newly registering to participate in soccer under the Phase 1 Return to Play Plan, the per player registration fee will be 50% of the primary per player registration fee. In other words, \$17.50 for players U11 and older and \$10.50 for players U10 and younger.

For Members and Affiliated Clubs operating in the Interior, North and Kootenay Regions this registration for new players will remain in effect until the commencement of the Interior Primary Season in 2021.

For Members and Affiliated Clubs operating in the Coastal Region (Lower Mainland & Island) this registration for new players will remain in effect until soccer is able to progress to the next phase of Return to Play for soccer (Phase 2). Note: any players that were registered for the Primary 2019-20 season (this past regular season play), registration is required as a returning player, however, no fee is collected by BC Soccer as the one-time annual fees have also been received.



Submission Deadlines from Youth Districts and Adult Leagues

The deadline to submit registration data for players participating in June & July Phase 1 Return to Play activity is July 31, 2020 via BC Soccer CRM.

As we look to towards the future phases, BC Soccer is also reviewing further ways to support Members and Affiliated Clubs from a financial perspective and once we have more information to share, we will do so.
