Position Overview

The Foundation Phase Directors are responsible for leading our U8 to U10 programming. Reporting to the Sporting director, the phase director's role is to manage and organize training and game days, support team volunteer coaches with meeting session and game day learning objectives, and supporting fluid player movement through our performance and play streams. The Boys and Girls Foundation Phase Director will work together to support mid-week training for the boys and girls, then manage the games either on Saturday (Boys) or Sunday (Girls)

Hours of Work

Part-Time hours, 3 days a week (20 hours per week on average) with the ability to work evenings and weekends as required to fulfill role objectives. Some periods of the year will see increased time commitments to align with soccer programming.

Programming days: Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday (Boys), Sunday (Girls)

Compensation

Part-Time monthly wage throughout the duration of the contract based on the successful candidate's qualifications and experience.

Contract Length

September to June (10 Months); Renewal yearly

Roles and Responsibilities include

- Program Management & Organization
- Training and game-day setup
- Manage and coordinate playing &/or training up opportunities for the players
- Support Sporting Director with player movement between Performance and Play streams
- Assist with competitive stream (Tier 1 & 2) player assessments & team formations
- Facilitate onboarding of new coaches
- Provide regular feedback and constructive observations to the coaches
- Provide ongoing education for the coaches on club development philosophy/guidelines
- Point of contact for coaches regarding game management, practice design & execution, player (&/or) parent management
- Design and deliver Coach Education events
- Support coaches with coach certification process
- Support Volunteer Coaches during sessions and games

- 2+ years of experience Coaching or leading programming within community soccer clubs
- Canada Soccer Association Children's license or equivalencies
