Hello, BC Soccer welcomes you to its Futsal Festival in the Fraser Valley!

Over the course of three days Players, Coaches and Referees will learn, or advance their current understanding of the basic rules of Futsal, how to effectively teach Futsal, and how to play futsal in their own community.

As part of increasing awareness about futsal, one representative from each team coaching staff must attend a two hour session on Wednesday night, December 30th, held at the Abbotsford University of Fraser Valley (UFV), Envision Athletic Centre.

Festival Overview:

A schedule of events is as follows:

❖ **Day 1: Pre-Festival Coaches and Referee Workshop (2 hours)**

A coach from each team is expected to attend the pre-festival workshop that will increase awareness about:

- Futsal and how it's played
- Futsal laws of the game
- Canada Soccer Associations Long Term Player Development (LTPD)
- Festival Logistics

❖ **Day 2: Grassroots Festival - technical focus (90 minutes)**

During the first day of the festival, teams will be split into two groups of approximately 5+ players. This will ensure players receive maximum involvement as well as feedback from team coaches and station leaders. Each group will rotate through a variety of skill stations including but not limited to:

Station Topics:

- Running with the Ball
- Passing & Receiving
- Shooting
- Ball Mastery
- Small-Sided Game experience
- Full Court experience

Each station will be run by team coaches with support and guidance from the BC Soccer Grassroots Tutors and players from the University of the Fraser Valley Women's Varsity Soccer team.

❖ **Day 3: Grassroots Festival - tactical focus (90 minutes)**

Teams will be reunited and play full-court 10 minutes games against each other in a jamboree format.

Concessions

A basic concession will be open for the duration of the event and will be staffed by volunteers from the University of Fraser Valley women's varsity soccer team.

Water

Clean drinking water (fountain/tap) will be available on site.

Footwear

Please bring indoor non-marking footwear appropriate for use on a hardwood gymnasium floor.

Change Rooms

Teams will have access to change rooms on site.

Parking

Pay parking is available out front of the facility.

First Aid

First aid will be on site provided by Sport Med BC in case of any injuries or emergency
