Policy Statement

The BC Soccer Development Grant's policy supports key initiatives of BC Soccer's strategic plan and provides alignment between Canada Soccer's Club Licensing Program and other national initiatives.

Purpose

To provide an effective framework for grant funding for members and affiliated organizations through a variety of soccer programs.

Standards

- BC Soccer Development Grants will fund soccer programs that meet the requirements of the below categories:
 - Accessibility
 - Diversity & Inclusion
 - Equity
 - Organizational Development
 - Grassroots Development
- Organizations are limited to one grant per fiscal year.
- BC Soccer will establish base funding allocations for each grant category.
- BC Soccer will, through the annual budget process, increase or decrease fund allocations in any of the categories
- Funds in each category are allocated to programs in response to trends, priority needs, and maximizing benefit and impact.

Definitions

- Grant: A one-time, annual allocation of funds from BC Soccer to a specific member or affiliated organization for a specific purpose which, through objective evaluation, meets the criteria in a specific grant category as expressed in the policy.
